

The Management Board of Feerum S.A., with its registered office in Chojnów (the “Issuer”), announces that on 10 June 2026 it received notification from the Egyptian state-owned company “The Egyptian Holding Company for Silos and Storage” (the “**Contracting Authority**”) regarding the outcome of an international tender (“Tender”) for the implementation of a project comprising the design, construction, manufacture, installation and commissioning of grain storage and drying facilities with a capacity of 90,000 tonnes in Dandara, Qena Governorate, Egypt, as well as the provision of training and the supply of spare parts (“Project”). The Issuer reported on the Tender in Current Report No. 27/2025 dated 18 November 2025.

In the Tender, the Contracting Authority has selected, in a binding and final manner, the bid for the implementation of the Project (“Bid”) submitted by a consortium comprising the Egyptian company Samcrete Egypt – Engineers & Contractors – S.A.E., acting as the consortium leader, and the Issuer (“Consortium”). The total value of the Bid is 649,319,329.00 Egyptian pounds (EGP) (equivalent to PLN 46,101,672.36 at the average exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland as at 10 June 2026) and 15,418.263.00 US dollars (USD) (which is equivalent to PLN 56,688,327.57 at the average exchange rate of the National Bank of Poland as at 10 June 2026). The amount specified in the previous sentence in US dollars constitutes the remuneration to which the Issuer will be entitled for the implementation of the Project.

In accordance with the tender documentation, within the next 28 days the Contracting Authority will enter into a contract with the Consortium for the implementation of the Project. The Issuer will announce the conclusion of the contract for the implementation of the Project in a separate announcement.
